What the course qualifies

This is a 5 day course that enables you to teach beginner children. An introduction to swimming teaching and basic essentials of teaching assessed by the STA – Swimming Teachers Association

Holders of this qualification are able to teach up to 10 beginners. They can also act as an assistant swimming teacher and may teach larger classes or advanced skills under direct supervision of a swimming teacher qualified to certificate level

Prerequisite to attend the course

- Be of 16 years of age or older
- Able to swim 25m (you will be required to demonstrate during the course)
- Hold current membership with STA
- Hold Safety Award for Teachers or acceptable equivalent
- Hold either the STA Safeguarding Children, Young People and Vulnerable Adults Certificate (Available STA Online) or acceptable equivalent

Validity of Award

The Qualification does not have an expiry date. To remain as an STA approved swimming teacher and to receive the benefit of STA public liability insurance, holders of the qualification are required to:

1. Remain in membership of the STA
2. Keep Knowledge up to date with regular CPD's
3. Keep their prerequisites lifesaving qualification in date
4. Regularly update their DBS Check
