



STA Safety Award for Teachers

What the course qualifies

Holders of the STA Safety Award for Teachers are capable in pool rescue, first aid, adult, child and infant CPR techniques

Holders will be competent to deal with poolside emergencies in accordance with The HSE Publication Managing Health and Safety in Swimming Pools and British Standard BS EN 15288 Part 2, Safety Requirements for Operations

Prerequisite to attend the course

- Be a minimum of 14 years of age
- Be able to recover and object from the deepest part of the pool
- Be able to swim 25 meters*

*If candidates cannot swim 25 meters, they must be able to demonstrate the ability to wade, and effecting a rescue, in a pool with a depth no greater and chest height

Validity of Award

The qualification is valid for 2 years

Length of Course

1 Day – 6 recommended guided learning hours
